



Designed, manufactured and assembled in Australia, the bikes to come out of Canberrabased Goodspeed Bicycle Co (http://www.goodspeed.com.au/) represent an evolved take on classic retro bicycle design. With emphasis on the value of utilising local skills and materials to construct their designs, they are a perfect example of small-scale manufacturing that can still find a comfortable niche in Australia.

Co-founder and industrial designer Myles Chandler says of the Goodspeed Bicycle Co aesthetic , "I wanted us to build a bike that was very elegant, to build a bike that was very practical, very solid, very tough, that would accommodate a broad range of riders, something different to your standard triangle frames. I want to build a bicycle that people won't feel intimidated by."
