
Five Australian destinations that should be on your road trip bucket list!

After seeing the sights, reward yourself with 360degree views from up top of Mount Ainslie, before checking out the burgeoning food and wine scene Canberra's fast-becoming known for. For something a little fancier before returning home, start with a salumi board at A.Baker, before devouring everything on the Monster Kitchen and Bar menu.

SWAN VALLEY, WA



Brimming with fresh produce, gourmet goods and many microbreweries, explore the galleries and workshops along the Food and Wine Trail, before checking out Swan Valley Heritage Cycle Trail and Caversham Wildlife Park.

MORNINGTON PENINSULA, VIC

n hour's drive south of Melbourne, Mornington Peninsula is a must-see spot. Hit the surf at Point Leo or Portsea, before checking out the multi-coloured bathing boxes at Mount Martha. Known for the finest local wines, restock at Montalto Vineyard and Olive Grove, before heading to DOC Mornington for a pizza. And because it's been such a tough day, check into Peninsula Hot Springs for a dip in the bathing pool before the drive home.
